Each September, libraries across the nation celebrate Library Card Sign-Up Month to ensure parents, educators, and students know that a library card is available and is a huge step toward achieving lifelong learning.

In 2022, MCL is teaming up with Marion Unit 2 schools to deliver information about Student Cards - available to all Marion Unit 2 students, even if they live outside of Marion - and Educator Cards - available to all Marion Unit 2 educators at absolutely no cost.
