**VIRTUAL REALITY HEADSET RELEASE FORM**

Due to the unpredictable nature of each individual's response to virtual reality (dizziness, nausea, seizures, anxiety, fear of heights, bumping into objects, etc.), all participants are required to sign this waiver releasing Marion Carnegie Library from any liability regarding your (or your child/dependent/minor's) use of the VR Headset.

YOU ARE ADVISED TO STOP USE OF THE VR HEADSET IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY DISCOMFORT.

I (or my child/dependent/minor) wish to participate in exploring virtual reality using a VR headset. I understand that for me (or my child/dependent/minor) to participate in using the VR headset, I agree to and understand the following:

- 1. I am voluntarily participating in the use of virtual reality.
- 2. I assume all of the physical, psychological, and financial risks associated with participating in the use of a VR headset.
- 3. I agree to immediately stop use of the VR headset if I experience any discomfort, including without limitation, dizziness, nausea, seizures, anxiety, fear of heights, and bumping into objects.

- 4. By signing, I acknowledge that I have read and understood all of the terms of this release form and that I am voluntarily giving up substantial legal rights, including the right to sue the City of Marion, Marion Carnegie Library, or their employees.
- 5. If the headset is being used by a child/dependent/minor, I am the parent or legal guardian of the minor named below. I have the legal right to consent to, and by signing below, I hereby do consent to the terms and conditions of this Release of Liability.
