Rides Mass Transit Offers \$1 Transportation on New Marion Route

Starting March 1, 2023, Rides Mass Transit's new "Wildcat Route" begins. The new route will offer a regular route through Marion with stops at Marion Carnegie Library, The Hub, Boyton Street Community Center, and more! Ask an MCL staff member for more information about stops along the Wildcat Route.

The route will run Monday through Friday, with stops at the library's new bus stop shelter - on the West side of the library's parking lot - every half-hour between 6:15 am and 5:45 pm on weekdays, and between 8:15 am and 5:45 pm on Saturdays.

This new route is **in addition** to the current transit

options available through Rides Mass Transit. Passengers can call 618-993-1900 to request door-to-door transportation, if unable to access a designated Wildcat Route stop.

"Marion Carnegie Library is so excited to be a part of the new Wildcat Route, and to help people access important places in their lives," says Loretta Broomfield, Director of MCL.

Wildcat Route fares are \$1.00 for individuals. Seniors and persons with disabilities could ride for half a fare, and those eligible for the Benefit Access Program could ride a fixed route at no cost.
