## **StoryWalk®**

<u>Children's Department brings the story outside of the library.</u>

In late 2022, the City of Marion and Marion Carnegie Library teamed up to create another family-friendly destination on and around Tower Square. From that idea came a permanent StoryWalk® installation, starting at MCL's Market Street entrance and continuing north and around the square.

Created by Anne Ferguson of Montpelier, Vermont, and developed with the help of Rachel Senechal, formerly of the Kellogg-Hubbard Library, StoryWalk® programming can be found across the country and has become a librarian favorite.

Shelley Hudspath, MCL's Coordinator of Children's Services, was instrumental in bringing the StoryWalk® project to life. "Josh Benson (Director of Marion Cultural and Civic Center) came to us with the idea in 2020 and reached out to all the downtown businesses," she says. "The businesses were so



accommodating and excited to be a part of this familyoriented program that brought people to the square. Now we hear from families all the time about how beautiful the new stands are and what a great idea it is!"

Since the permanent StoryWalk® pedestals were installed, books like "Pick a Pine Tree" by Patricia Toht and "Mae Among the Stars" by Roda Ahmed have been featured. More StoryWalk® experiences are on the way in Spring and Summer 2023 and they'll always start at MCL's historic Market Street entrance.
