- 1. Personnel: With two new hires in January, the library is now fully staffed.
- 2. Building and Grounds: The main floor study room is now open for the first time since the start of the pandemic. In only a few days, the room has been used several times. An online system is being used for booking so users can reserve the room from home. A small air purifier will be bought for the room.
- 3. Financial: Draft of proposed FY 2024 budget was presented. No drastic changes from last year.
- 4. Friends: Book sale March 10 & 11
- 5. Technology: Loretta filed the first E-Rate application form for internet and for telecommunication equipment. E-Rate normally pays 80% of internet expenses.
