Marion Carnegie Library is proud to host Chicago's Adler Planetarium and their "Astro Road Trip" presentation at 5 pm and 6 pm on Tuesday, April 2.

This Adler staff-led presentation will feature information about the upcoming solar eclipse and what to expect in Marion. Everyone who attends will be able to participate in fun demonstrations about how solar eclipses work and how to safely view a solar eclipse, and to interact with Adler's lunar meteorite.
